

Inbound Student Information

Basic Course: Contact the Marine Detachment Office during regular business hours (0700-1630) at (757) 462-7504. Nighttime arrivals will be signed in by the OOD and assigned billeting at Scott Hall. Check into the Marine Detachment in SVC "A". You may stay in a hotel and be reimbursed if you arrive early or catch some rest in the USO following a flight (advised).

Basic Students are required to have the following items in their possession upon arrival:

- All issued gear from Recruit Training
- Service Record Book
- Medical Record
- Dental Record
- Travel receipts

Unlike many in-service schools, you may come accompanied by a spouse to the School of Music. You may also have your privately owned vehicle. Shipping or carrying a personal instrument is encouraged, though all necessary instrumental needs will be provided by the school.

Issues to be reported upon arrival:

- Injuries or persistent physical issues as a result of training
- Pending legal matters
- Pay discrepancies
- Family emergencies

Students are required to have all issued gear from Recruit Training in their possession as well as their Service Record Book and Medical and Dental records upon arrival.

Following completion of the check-in process, new Marines will be given an incoming audition to reassess their instrumental skill. New Marines will also be given an incoming diagnostic exam to assess their knowledge of music theory and dictation of intervals, rhythms, and melody.

For those staying in the barracks, take note that the following items are prohibited:

- Weapons
- Blades longer than 3"
- Candles
- Cookware with a heat source (toaster oven, hotplate)
- Coffee makers/kettles larger than 12 cups
- Alcoholic beverages of any kind
